- 1.0000 Objects contain the possibility of all statuses of affairs.
- 2.0000 The possibility of its occurrence in atomic facts is the form of the object.
- 2.0100 Objects form the substance of the world. Therefore they cannot be compound.
- 2.0101 If the world had no substance, then whether a proposition had sense would depend on whether another proposition was true.
- 2.0200 It would then be impossible to form a picture of the world (true or false).
