

1.0000 Objects contain the possibility of all statuses of affairs.

2.0000 The possibility of its occurrence in atomic facts is the form of the object.

2.0100 Objects form the substance of the world. Therefore they cannot be compound.

2.0101 If the world had no substance, then whether a proposition had sense would depend on whether another proposition was true.

2.0200 It would then be impossible to form a picture of the world (true or false).
